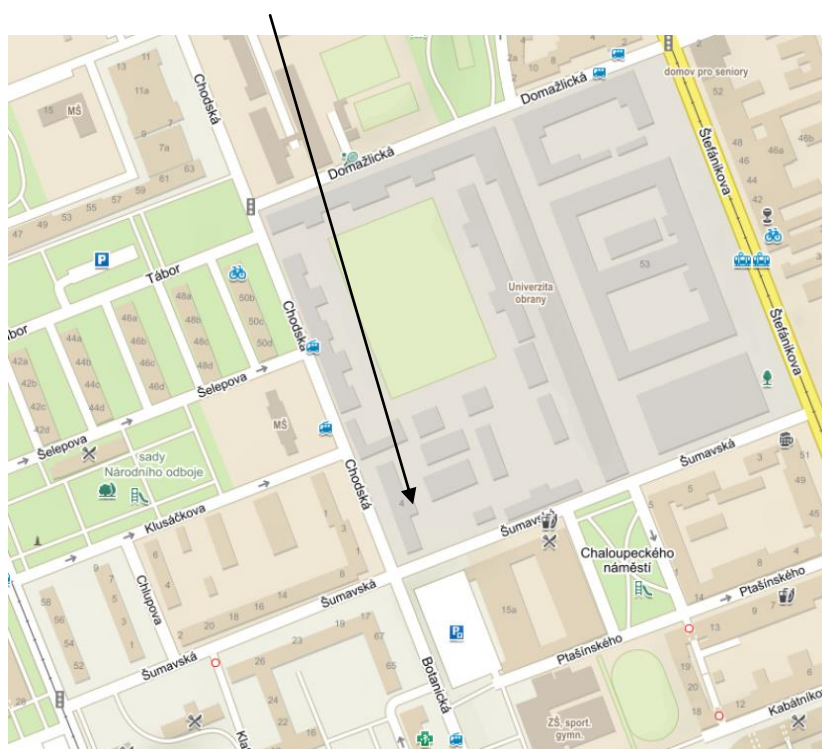


# Invitation to the 8<sup>th</sup> conference MITAV MITAV 2021

Union of Czech Mathematicians and Physicists, Brno branch (JČMF) cordially invite you to the conference **MITAV (Mathematics, Information Technologies, and Applied Sciences)**, organized in co-operation with the Faculty of Military Technology of the University of Defence in Brno, Faculty of Science, Faculty of Education and Faculty of Economics and Administration of Masaryk University in Brno and Faculty of Electrical Engineering and Communication of Brno University of Technology.

The conference MITAV 2021 will take place in the **Club of the University of Defence, Brno, Šumavská 4, June 17 and 18, 2021.**



## **Aims and target group of the conference**

The conference **MITAV 2021** is the eighth annual MITAV conference. It should attract in particular teachers of all types of schools and is devoted to the most recent discoveries in mathematics, informatics, and other sciences as well as to the teaching of these branches at all kinds of schools for any age groups, including e-learning and other applications of information technologies in education. The organizers wish to pay attention especially to the education in the areas that are indispensable and highly demanded in contemporary society. The goal of the conference is to create space for the presentation of results achieved in various branches of science and at the same time provide the possibility for meeting and mutual discussions of teachers from different kinds of schools and orientation. We also welcome presentations by (diploma and doctoral) students and teachers who are just beginning their careers, as their novel views and approaches are often interesting and stimulating for other participants.

The MITAV 2021 conference will be run in the following sections:

1. International
  - official language: **English**
2. National (focused on general questions of education at primary, secondary schools and universities)
  - official languages: **Czech, Slovak**
  - Organizers are convinced that among teachers are many of those who are using innovative methods, who solved interesting projects, who have experience in interdisciplinary education, etc. Especially contributions of these teachers are welcome.

### Instructions for conference participants

- Send the filled-in application form for MITAV 2021 and your conference paper in Czech, Slovak or English **by April 30, 2021** to [mitav.conference@gmail.com](mailto:mitav.conference@gmail.com). Please, use the template (MITAV\_template) and send your contribution in docx (doc) or TeX and also always in pdf formats.
- The authors are responsible for the content and formal layout of the contributions. Checking the papers and the decision about their acceptance are in the competence of Czech members of the international programme committee. All the papers which will be in compliance with content and formal requirements will be included on the conference CD (supplement of the printed Collection of abstracts MITAV 2021).
- The time allocated to presentation of the contribution at the conference is 15 minutes including discussion. The MITAV 2021 participants who will not be able to present their papers in Brno personally, can send the appropriate video file. This video file will be included on the conference CD. A notebook and a data projector will be available for the speakers at the conference room.
- The programme of the conference will be available by June 7, 2021.
- Selected contributions (presented personally or by video file) can be updated by their authors after the conference. Original or updated conference contributions which will be sent to [mitav.conference@gmail.com](mailto:mitav.conference@gmail.com) by **September 20, 2021**, will be peer-reviewed by two independent reviewers from different countries.
- The final update of contributions according to the reviewers' recommendations will be the authors' exclusive right.
- Finally, the reviewers will decide definitely if the contributions will be accepted to the post-conference proceedings of selected papers, or not. The proceedings will be sent to the process of Web of Science indexation by the end of 2021.

Each MITAV 2021 participant will receive printed **Collection of abstracts MITAV 2021** with ISBN. **CD supplement** of this printed volume will contain all the accepted contributions of the conference and video files of participants who cannot present their papers in Brno personally.

In autumn 2021, a **post-conference CD proceedings** with ISBN (different from the ISBN collection of abstracts) will be published, containing updated and possibly extended versions of selected MITAV 2021 contributions.

The proceedings will be published in English and will be sent to the Web of Science database of **Clarivate Analytics** (earlier Thomson Reuters) (<https://apps.webofknowledge.com>) for consideration.

**Post-conference CD proceedings of selected papers extended versions from MITAV conferences** (see at <http://mitav.unob.cz>) are being sent to the Web of Science of **Clarivate Analytics** (earlier Thomson Reuters). The MITAV 2016, 2017 and 2018 proceedings have been indexed yet. Other proceedings are in the process.
